

# Indices of Deprivation 2025: Park Ward



## Introduction

The Indices of Deprivation 2025 provide information about deprivation in small neighbourhoods. They include the Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) which is the official measure of deprivation for a neighbourhood. This report summarises IoD results for the Park Ward. Results are reported for small areas called Lower Layer Super Output areas. Each LSOA has approximately 1,600 people. The summary includes:

- A map showing IMD national decile results for the LSOAs in this ward;
- Four tables summarising:
  1. Number of neighbourhoods in the 10%, 20% and 30% most deprived neighbourhoods in England by each IoD Domain;

  3. Percentage of residents that are Income deprived, or Employment deprived according to IoD;
  4. Ward average for each IoD domain and index

### Key results for this ward

- This ward has ten LSOAs. Nine are within the 10% most deprived nationally for England, and one within the 10% to 20% most deprived.

According to IoD:

- 57.7% of residents are income deprived compared with 26.3% for Calderdale.
- 66.6% of children aged 0-15 live in income-deprived households compared with 40.1% for Calderdale
- 55.5% of older people aged 60 or above are income deprived compared with 16.8% for Calderdale.
- 29.7% of working age people are employment deprived compared to 16.5% for Calderdale.

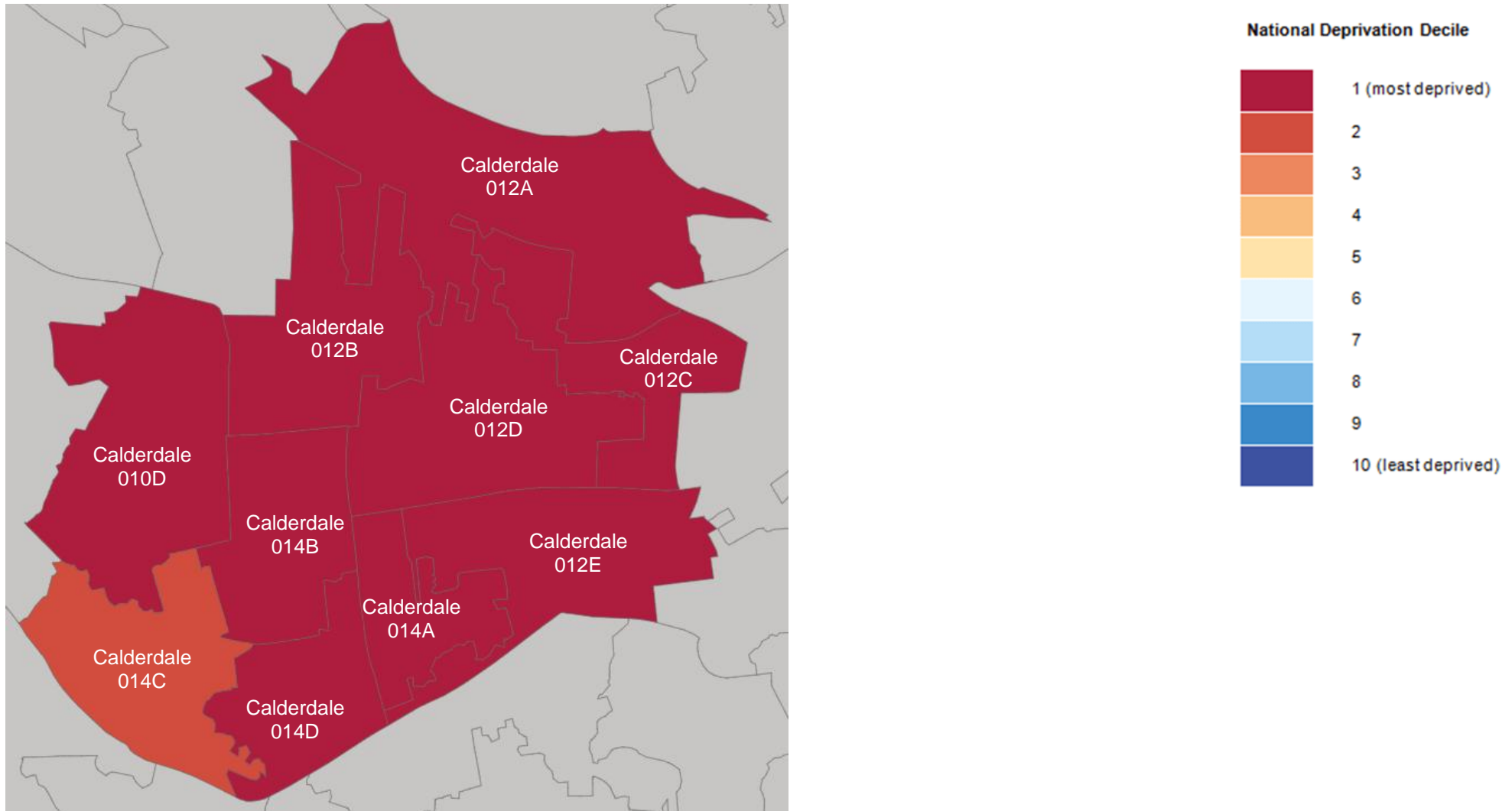
- For IMD 2025 Park Ward is ranked 1 out of 17 wards in Calderdale where 1 = most deprived.
- IMD 2025 ranks this ward within the 10% most deprived decile nationally.

### Background information

- The IoD are based on seven individual domains called Income, Employment, Education Skills and Training, Health and Disability, Crime, Barriers to Housing and Services, and Living Environment.
- IoD includes two supplementary indices for the Income domain of
  - children in families with income deprivation (IDACI) and
  - people aged 60+ with income deprivation (IDAOPI).
- LSOAs were originally developed by the Office for National Statistics for reporting results of similar population sizes. LSOAs tend to be smaller in urban areas and bigger in rural areas due to differences in population density.
- There are 33,755 LSOAs in England of which 129 are in Calderdale and ten in this ward.
