

The remaining dashboards show results over time and / or in comparison to other local authorities.




4 Ward and LSOA overviews

move the mouse over the filter.



5 Outcomes Framework Dashboard




6 Benefits summaries by ward and LSOA

Use the "Benefit filter" to find results a selection of benefits.




Use the "Ward filter" in the LSOA dashboard to select LSOA results for one or more wards.




7 Ward and LSOA maps and charts

There are 27 dashboards which show results over time.



There are 128 LSOAs in Calderdale. Each LSOA has a label: eg Calderdale 001A and a code eg E01010911
KS2 RWM	Key stage 2 Reading Writing and Mathematics. An acronym included in measures used to assess the number and proportion of pupils sitting key stage 2 tests in reading, writing and mathematics who achieve the expected standard in all three.
