

The 2015 Index of Multiple Deprivation : Greetland and Stainland Ward



Introduction

The English Indices of Multiple Deprivation 2015 (IMD 2015) is the latest official Government measure of relative deprivation for small areas. It is based on seven individual domains called Income, Employment, Education Skills and Training, Health and Disability, Crime, Barriers to Housing and Services, and Living Environment. There are two supplementary indices for income deprived children (IDACI) and people aged 60+ (IDAOPI). IMD 2015 includes measures of relative deprivation for small areas of approximately 1,500 residents, called Lower Layer Super Output areas (LSOAs). There are 32,844 LSOAs in England of which 128 are in Calderdale and 7 in Greetland and Stainland Ward.

This report summarises IMD 2015 results for the LSOAs in this ward. This includes overall results and results for the seven individual domains and the two supplementary indices.

- Table 1 lists the number of LSOAs in the 10%, 20% and 30% most deprived nationally for Greetland and Stainland Ward and Calderdale
- Table 2 lists the relative rank and percentage rank for LSOAs in this ward compared to all LSOAs in England.
- Table 3 lists the percentage of residents', children and older people who are income deprived and percentage of working age people who are employment deprived.
- The map on page 3 shows the IMD 2015 percentage result for each LSOA in the Ward compared with all LSOAs in England.

***Income Deprivation among children Index (IDACI)** measures the proportion of children aged 0-15 in families that are in receipt of Income Support, income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, Pension Credit Guarantee or Child Tax Credit below a given threshold. **Income Deprivation among Older People index (IDAOPI)** measures the proportion of older people aged 60+ that are in receipt of Income Support, income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, Pension Credit Guarantee or Child Tax Credit below a given threshold

Index of Multiple Deprivation for Greetland and Stainland

A Lower Super Output Area (LSOA) is a small geographical unit of approximately 1,500 households. This map shows the ranking of relative deprivation against all other LSOAs in England. The higher the percentage, the lower the level of deprivation.
