



# IoD 2019: Employment deprivation domain

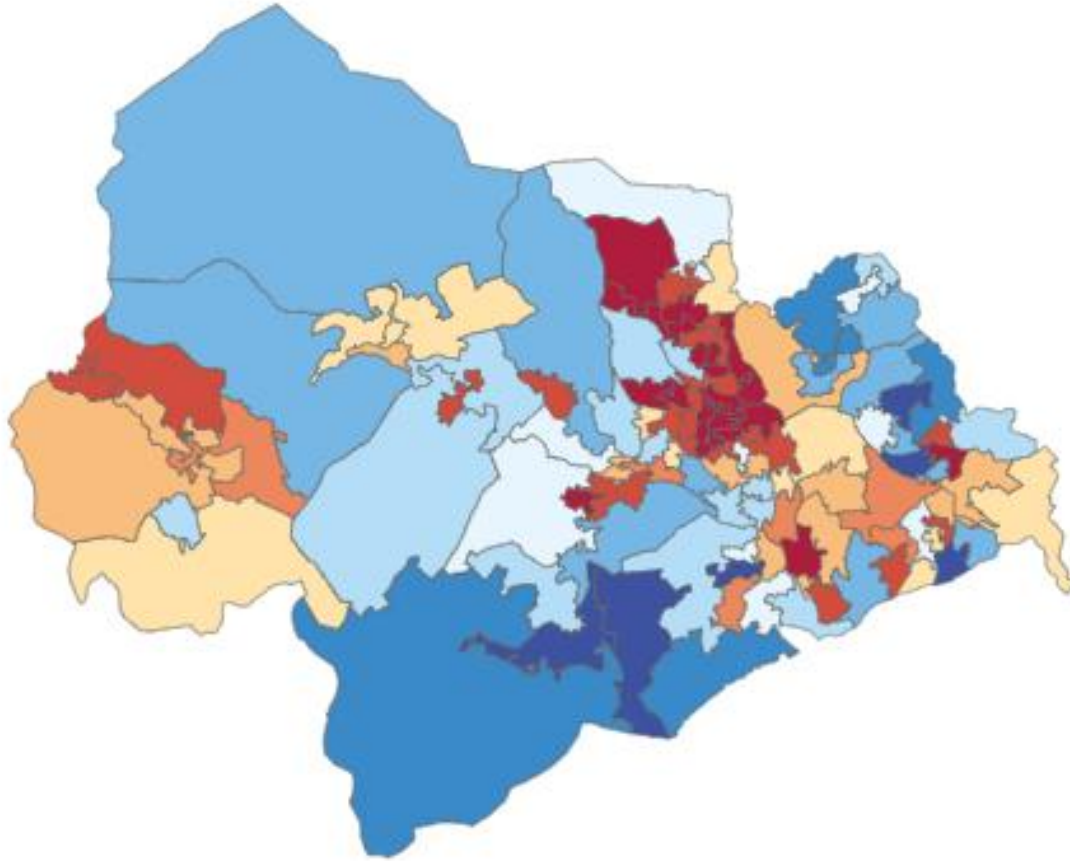
The Employment Deprivation Domain measures employment deprivation conceptualised as involuntary exclusion of the working age population from the world of work. People who would like to work but are unable to do so through unemployment, sickness or disability. This table summarises the number of neighbourhoods in Calderdale that are within 30% most deprived in England for this domain.

The English Indices of Deprivation (IoD) use LSOAs to report statistics for neighbourhood areas. LSOA is short for lower-layer super output area. LSOAs typically include populations about 1,600 people.

There are 33,755 LSOAs in England of which 129 are in Calderdale.
