



Indices of Deprivation 2025: Crime Domain

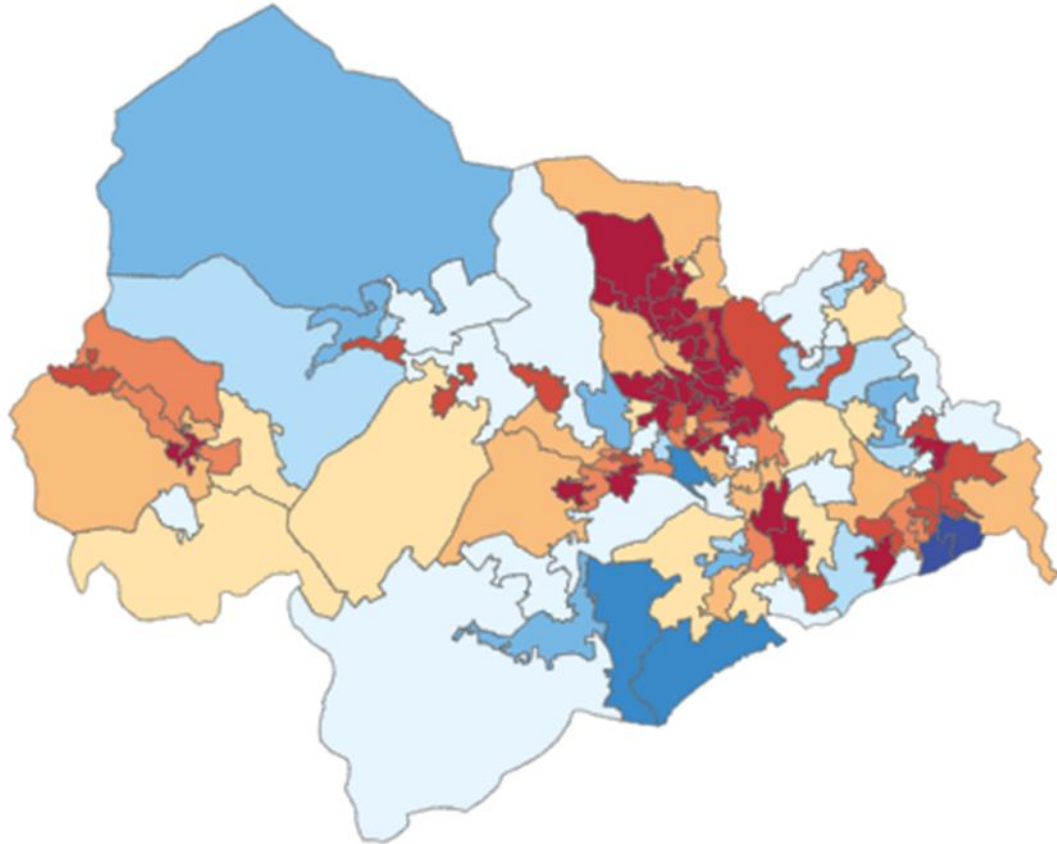
Crime is an important feature of deprivation that has major effects on individuals and communities. The Crime Domain measures the risk of personal and material victimisation at local level. The table summarises the number of neighbourhoods in Calderdale that are within 30% most deprived in England for this domain.

The English Indices of Deprivation (IoD) use LSOAs to report statistics for neighbourhood areas. LSOA is short for lower-layer super output area. LSOAs typically include populations about 1,600 people.

There are 33,755 LSOAs in England of which 129 are in Calderdale.

IoD 2025: Crime domain Measures

- Violence with injury, rate per 1,000 at risk population, 2018/19 to 2023/24
- Violence without injury, rate per 1,000 at risk population, 2018/19 to 2023/24
- Stalking and harassment, rate per 1,000 at risk population, 2018/19 to 2023/24
- Burglary, rate per 1,000 at risk properties, 2018/19 to 2023/24
- Theft, rate per 1,000 at risk population, 2018/19 to 2023/24
- Criminal damage, rate per 1,000 at risk population, 2018/19 to 2023/24
- Public order and possession of weapons, rate per 1,000 at risk population, 2018/19 to 2023/24
- Anti-social behaviour, rate per 1,000 at risk population, 2022/23 and 2023/24
